Preliminary judging in this year's Independent Publisher Book Awards is complete. Here are the semi-finalists in all 58 categories, 4 – 12 titles each, depending on the size of the category and the quality of the titles entered. These titles all receive honorable mention from the IPPY Awards judges. A winner and two finalists will be chosen in each category and announced on May 23rd. The Ten Outstanding Books of the Year will also be announced at that time, and candidates for those awards are not necessarily included in this list of semi-finalists. Presentation of the ninth Annual Independent Publisher Book Awards takes place on June 3rd during BookExpo America.
